Jason DeJong, Ph.D., is a professor at the University of California, Davis. He is also the director of the NSF NHERI Center for Geotechnical Modeling and the UC Davis lead for the NSF ERC Center for Bio-mediated and Bio-inspired Geotechnics. DeJong's major technical achievements have been in the areas soil and site characterization, biogeotechnics, earthquake engineering and geotechnical sustainability. Results from his research program have been disseminated through more than 250 publications, and his work has been recognized through several awards including the ASTM International Hogentogler Award, ICE TK Hsieh Prize, ASCE Prakash Award and as an ASCE Fellow.
